320th Bombardment Group (M).

HEIDELBERG RAILROAD BRIDGE (M/R: (W) R-673907, GSGS 4416, sheet U-3), Germany.

At 10:17 hours, 29 B-26's took off to bomb Heidelberg Railroad Bridge (M/R: (W) R-673907, GSGS 4416, sheet U-3), Germany. 2 B-26's returned early: spares.  
Total sorties: 27. 27 B-26's were over the Primary target and 27 B-26's dropped 107 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .01 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 12:34 hours from 12,000' on an axis of 265°T. 1 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bomb was salvoed at 13:31 hours in the lake south of Dijon (rack malfunction).. No bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. 3 B-26's slightly damaged by flak, 27 B-26's returned to base at 13:51 hours.
