320th Bombardment Group (M).

HEILBRONN M/Y (M/R: (W) S-064604, GOG 4416, Sheet V-3), Germany.

At 11:09 hours, 29 B-26's took off to bomb Heilbronn M/Y (M/R: (W) S-064604, GOG 4416, Sheet V-3), Germany. 2 B-26's returned early: 1 engine cutting out; 1 spare. Total sorties: 27. 27 B-26's were over the Primary target and 9 B-26's dropped 70 x 500-lb. Incendiary "M-17" cluster bombs with M-138 nose fuses set at 21.5 seconds on the second bomb run on the Primary target at 13:19 hours from 11,700' to 10,700' on an Axis of 195°T. No bombs were salvoed. 144 x 500-lb. Incendiary bombs (clusters) were returned to base, not having been dropped visually due to cloud cover and not having been dropped on instruments due to malfunction of ground equipment. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 27 B-26's returned to base at 14:53 hours.

ROUTE: Same as Report No. 537, this date, except the axis of attack was 195°T.

WEATHER: See Report No. 537, this date.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: The squadron which dropped, bombed on an attempted combination of "G-Box" and "Bat", as cloud cover prevented visual bombing and "Bat" could not be used due to malfunction of ground equipment.

RESULTS: The target was missed. The bombs were reported by crews to have landed in woods 10 miles south of the target.
