At 08:40 hours, 41 B-26's took off to bomb Klein Enstingen Ammunition Storage Area, West $\frac{1}{2}$ of Area "F" (M/R: (W) X-150750, GSGS 4416, Sheet W-3), Germany. 5 B-26's returned early: 3 "BAT" a/c called back; 1 loss of power; 1 oil congealed. Total sorties: 36. 36 B-26's were over the Primary target, but no bombs were dropped because cloud on the bomb run and heavy haze prevented identification of the target in time for bombing.
