KLEIN ENGSTINGEN WEST AMMUNITION DUMP, SOUTH-WEST PORTION OF AREA "B" (M/R: (W) X-110740, GSGS 4416, sheet W-3), Germany.

At 08:10 hours, 27 B-26's took off to bomb Kleinengstingen West Ammunition Dump, south-west Portion of Area "B" (M/R: (W) X-110740, GSGS 4416, sheet W-3), Germany. No B-26's returned early. Total sorties: 27. 27 B-26's were over the Primary target and 27 B-26's dropped 766 x 100-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & non-delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 10:40 hours from 12,000' to 11,000' on an axis of 50°T (briefed Axis - 45°T; drift correction - 04° left; evasive action - loss of 1,000' altitude). 26 x 100-lb. Demolition bombs were salvoed at 10:40 hours at the target and 7 x 100-lb. Demolition bombs were salvoed in lake 10 miles south of Dijon per "SOP". No bombs were returned to base. One a/c carried only 20 x 100-lb. Demolition bombs and another a/c carried only 29 x 100-lb. Demolition bombs. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 27 B-26's returned to base at 12:10 hours.

WEATHER: CAVU in all areas.

RESULTS: An excellent concentration of bombs covered the assigned area. The pattern started slightly short to the South-west and walked to North-east edge. A large explosion occurred on the North-east edge of the area. Smoke was seen reaching 10,000' and could be seen for 70 miles (based on photos & interrogations).

SPECIAL COMMENTS: This was a visual mission.
