340th Bombardment Group (H).

TO BOMB PER "COCONUT PLAN", ALTERNATE TARGET, KLEIN WAGENZEN WEST AMMUNITION DUMP, SOUTH-WEST PORTION OF AREA "B" (W/R: (A) X-110740; GSRS 4416, Sheet N-3), Germany.

At 09:26 hours, 18 B-26's took off to bomb per "Coconut Plan", Alternate target, Klein Wagenzen West Ammunition Dump, South-West Portion of Area "B" (W/R: (A) X-110740, GSRS 4416, Sheet N-3), Germany. No B-26's returned early. 1 B-26 landed at Luneville enroute to the target on single-engine. Total Sorties: 17. 17 B-26's were over the Alternate target per instruction from "Coconut Controller", and 17 B-26's dropped 134 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the alternate target at 12:20 hours from 12,000' on an axis of 70° T. No bombs were salvaged or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 17 B-26's returned to base at 13:55 hours.

AIR OBSERVATIONS:

a. Activity:

- (1) 14 P-47's provided escort.
- (2) At 12:48 hours 2 S/S a/c, dark in color, headed north at 4,000' in area of Heilbronn.

b. Situation: 2 S/S a/c on ground at Geppingen A/B at S-4113.

ENEMY AIR ENCOUNTERS: None. Losses to E/A: None. Damaged by E/A: None. Claimed E/A: None.

FLAK: None. Losses to Flak: None. Damaged by Flak: None.

GROUND OBSERVATIONS:

a. General:

- (1) Two black vapor trails, 250' in length observed at 11,000', one headed North, the other South, at 11:50 hours at S-1649.

- (2) 3 oil tanks, camouflaged, in wooded area South-West of Springen at N-9557 at 12:16 hours.

b. Communications:

- (1) 35 RR cars and 2 locomotives at S-2340 at 12:00 hours.
- (2) 100 RR cars at X-1988 at 12:10 hours.
- (3) 100 RR cars and 4 locomotives at S-4113 at 12:26 hours.
- (4) 20 RR cars at N-9558 at 12:16 hours.
- (5) 6/8 tanks 2 miles South of Heilbronn B-1552, no movement, at 12:40 hours.

CASUALTIES: None.

ROUTE: Base to Minal; to Saverne 4-7216; to rendezvous at Hammheim R-5398; to Jagstfeld 8-6771; to Goppingen 8-4111; to Neutlin, 8-1089; to Bingen 8-9558; turn right to Bingen 8-9558, IP.; to Target on an axis of 76° T (briefed axis - 46° T; drift correction - 03° left; evasive action - loss of altitude); slight break to left to Goppingen 8-4111; reciprocal course to base.

INSTRUMENTS: CAVU in all areas.

RESULTS: Bombs of 1st Squadron fell just North-East of the target area, causing explosions; 2nd Squadron's bombs hit in assigned area, no explosions observed.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: This was a visual mission.
