320th Bombardment Group (M).

SCHWEINFURT TOWN, AREA #1, (M/R: (W) N-785638, GSGS 4416, Sheet T-4), Germany.

At 14:10 hours, 71 B-26's took off to bomb Schweinfurt Town, Area #1 (M/R: (W) N-785638, GSGS 4416, Sheet T-4), Germany. 2 B-26's returned early: propeller governors out. Total Sorties: 69. 69 B-26's were over the Primary target and 69 B-26's dropped 136 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .01 second delay tail fuses) and 280 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .01 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 17:02 hours from 12,000' to 8,800' on an Axis of 90°T and 74°T (briefed Axis - 88°T; drift correction - 03° right; evasive action - loss of 1,500' altitude and slight evasive action). No bombs were salvaged or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. 1 B-26 slightly damaged by flak. 68 B-26's returned to base at 18:41 hours. 1 B-26 returned to base late at 19:30 hours after landing in Luneville for gas.

AIR OBSERVATIONS:a. Activity:

- (1) P-47's provided escort from Landau to target and return.
- (2) 1 black S/E a/c at Aschaffenburg N-1254 at 17:10 hours.
- (3) 4 P-51's headed North-West, East of Mannheim R-6799, at 15,000' at 16:30 hours.
- (4) 2 P-38's headed South-East at 16:30 hours at 14,000' South of Mannheim at R-4290.

b. Situation: None.

ENEMY AIR ENCOUNTERS: None. Losses to E/A: None. Damaged by E/A: None.
Claimed E/A: None.

FLAK: S, H, I, I, -CP type flak encountered from the target. Commenced 20 seconds before bombs away and continued for 20 seconds after breakaway. No flak was encountered by first 36 a/c. Total of 30 bursts were seen, of which 5/6 were accurate.

Losses to Flak: None. Damaged by Flak: 1 Category I.

GROUND OBSERVATIONS:a. General:

- (1) Large oil fire with black smoke reaching to 4,000' at North side of Schweinfurt N-7865 at 17:02 hours.
- (2) 12 tanks, stationary, at Maibach N-7469 at 17:02 hours.
- (3) 5 M/T moving East at N-8763 at 17:02 hours.

CASUALTIES: None.No. of A/C TAKING PHOTOS: 17.

ROUTE: Base to Epinal; to Saverne Q-7316; to Mannheim R-5499; to Aschaffenburg N-0254;; first 36 a/c- to IP, Lamr, N-3257; to target on an axis of 90° T; second 36 a/c to IP, Karlstadt, N-4653; to target on an Axis of 74° T; breakaway left to Glenhausen N-0380; to Frankfurt; to Saverne; to base.

WEATHER: CAVU in all areas.

RESULTS: In General, the target area was well covered by good patterns of bombs. Those of one Squadron were slightly short and left to the North-West, walking thru the target. Those of another Squadron were over and right to the South-East, with some bombs in the target area.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: This was a visual mission.

Correction: Add to Communications General: Red crosses on buildings near target. Nos. 2 and 3 under General should be under Communications.
