320th Bombardment Group (M).

JAFFE DEFENSE AREA, AREA "B" (M/R: (V) Y-385790, GSOS 4249, Sheet 6M), France.

At 07:48 hours, 18 B-26's took off to bomb Jaffe Defense Area, Area "B" (M/R: (V) Y-385790, GSOS 4249, Sheet 6M), France. No B-26's returned early. Total Sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the Primary target and 9 B-26's dropped 33 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 09:50 hours from 10,600' on an Axis of 256°T (briefed Axis - 255°T; drift correction - 02° right; evasive action - loss of altitude) and 9 B-26's were over the Primary target and 9 B-26's dropped 36 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the second bomb run on the Primary target at 10:08 hours from 12,700' on an Axis of 254°T (briefed Axis - 255°T; drift correction - 03° right; evasive action - loss of altitude), having not identified the target on the first bomb run. 2 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs were salvoed at 11:15 hours in lake 10 miles South of Dijon, having hung up over the target. (1 a/c carried only 3 x 1,000-lb. Demolition bombs). No Bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 11:50 hours.

- Situations: 1 4-engine a/c on the ground at (V) Y-2850 at 10:09 hours.
