At 14:04 hours, 18 B-26's took off to bomb Coubre Defense Area, bounded by (V) Y-215834, (V) Y-240838, and (V) Y-237867, Area "E", GSGS 4249, Sheet 6M, France. No B-26's returned early. Total Sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the Primary target on two bomb-runs, at 16:13 hours and 16:31 hours. 9 B-26's dropped 70 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the second bomb-run, necessitated by smoke obscuring the target, on the Primary target at 16:31 hours from 11,300' on an Axis of 60°T (briefed Axis - 69°T; drift correction - 04° left; evasive action - loss of altitude). The first Squadron made three (3) bomb-runs (third bomb-run at 16:43 hours), but did not drop, due to smoke obscuring the target. 7 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs were dropped at 16:30 hours at (V) Y-1983, part in the water and part on the beach, due to accidental release. 65 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) were returned to base, not having been dropped as stated above (one a/c carried only 6 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs). No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 18:23 hours.
