320th Bombardment Group (M).

COUBRE DEFENSE AREA, bounded by (V)Y-215834, (V) Y-237867, and (V) Y-240838, Area "C", GSGS 4249, Sheet 6M, France.

At 14:25 hours, 18 B-26's took off to bomb Coubre Defense Area, bounded by (V) Y-215834, (V) Y-240838, and (V) Y-237867, Area "C", GSGS 4249, Sheet 6M, France. No B-26's returned early. Total Sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the Primary target and 9 B-26's dropped 72 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target on the first bomb-run at 16:35 hours from 10,800' on an Axis of 85°T (briefed Axis - 69°T; drift correction - 03° left; evasive action - loss of altitude), 9 B-26's were over the Primary target and 9 B-26's dropped 72 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 16:49 hours from 10,200' on an Axis of 96 T, on the second bomb-run (briefed Axis - 69°T; drift correction - 03° left; evasive action - loss of 500' altitude). No Bombs were salvaged or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 18:31 hours.
