320th Bombardment Group (M).

COUBRE DEFENSE AREA, bounded by (V) Y-215834, (V) Y-240838, and (V) Y-237867, Area "C", GSCS 4249, Sheet 6M), France.

At 15:15 hours, 18 B-26's took off to bomb Coubre Defense Area, bounded by (V) Y-215834, (V) Y-240838, and (V) Y-237867, Area "C", GSCS 4249, Sheet 6M), France. No B-26's returned early. Total Sorties: 18. 18 B-26's were over the Primary target and 9 B-26's dropped 72 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the second bomb run at 17:37 hours from 11,200' on an Axis of 69°T, and 9 B-26's were over the Primary target on the third bomb-run and 9 B-26's dropped 72 x 500-lb. Demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 17:51 hours from 10,600' on an Axis of 80°T (briefed Axis - 69°T; drift correction 03° right; evasive action - loss of altitude). No bombs were salvoed or returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. 1 B-26 reported to have crash-landed at Chalindrey (W) J-3619; crew safe; reason unknown. No B-26's missing. No B-26's damaged. 10 B-26's returned to base at 19:14 hours and 5 B-26's returned to base late at 21:00 hours, after landing at Cognac for gas. 2 B-26's have not returned to base and are at Cognac. (This target was heavily obscured by smoke, necessitating additional bomb-runs.) The formation was over the target on the first bomb-run at 17:23 hours.
