## 320th Bombardment Group (M)

ALT. DETTELSAU AMMUNITION DUMP, AREA "A" (M/R: (W) T-203805, CGCS 4416, sheet U5), Germany.

At 10:55 hours, 30 B-26's took off to bomb Alt. Dettelsau Ammunition Dump, Area "A" (M/R: (W) T-203805, CGCS 4416, Sheet U5), Germany. 3 B-26's returned early: spares. Total Sorties: 27. 27 B-26's were over the Primary target and 9 B-26's dropped 124 x 260-lb. Fragmentation bombs (Inst. Nose & non-delay tail fuses) on the first bomb-run on the Primary target at 13:00 hours from 12,400' on an Axis of 38°T (briefed Axis - 50°T; drift correction - 04° right; evasive action - loss of altitude) and 27 B-26's were over the Primary target on the second bomb-run, and 17 B-26's dropped 234 x 260-lb. Fragmentation bomb (Inst. Nose & non-delay tail fuses) on the Primary target at 13:16 hours from 11,500' on an Axis of 30°T (briefed Axis - 50°T; drift correction - none; evasive action - loss of altitude). The second Squadron did not drop on the first bomb-run, because of inter-phone malfunction. 14 x 260-lb. Fragmentation bombs were salvoed at 13:16 hours at the target, due to bombardier error. No bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 27 B-26's returned to base at 14:47 hours.

ROUTE: Base to Spinal V-0454; to Saverne Q-7216; to Speyer R-5080; to Crailsheim S-7063; to Dinkelsbuhl S-8956; to IP, S-9957; to target on an Axis of 38°T, on the first bomb-run; breakaway left to Dinkelsbuhl S-8956; to IP, S-9957; to target on an Axis of 30°T, on the second bomb-run; breakaway left to Crailsheim S-7063; reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER: Clear; vis. 6 to 8 miles in all areas.

RESULTS: Excellent bomb patterns covered the target, causing several large explosions and fires.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: This was a "BAT" mission.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: The two (2) a/c, which remained at Cognac from the last mission of 16 April 1945, returned to base at 12:50 hours, 17 April 1945.
