SCHUSSENRIED L/G & DISPERSAL AREA, AREAS 1, 2, & 3 (M/R: (W) X-425376, GSGB 4416, Sheet X-4), Germany.

At 10:45 hours, 63 B-26's took off to bomb Schussenried L/G & Dispersal Area, Areas 1, 2, & 3 (M/R: (W) X-425376, GSGB 4416, Sheet X-4), Germany. No B-26's returned early. Total Sorties: 63. 63 B-26's were over the Primary target on two bomb-runs. No bombs were dropped on the first bomb-run, due to clouds obscuring the target. First bomb-run was made at 13:03 hours. 18 B-26's dropped 2,121 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs on the Primary target on the second bomb-run at 13:22 hours from 11,800' to 10,800' on an Axis of 219° T (briefed Axis - 221° T: drift correction - 06¹⁸ left; evasive action - loss of 1,000' altitude and mild lateral). 36 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs were salvoed at 13:24 hours on the breakaway from the target, having hung up. 3 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs were returned to base, having hung up over the target. 2 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs were jettisoned at W-2262 at 13:51 hours through the camera hatch by one of the a/c which did not drop on the target, having fallen from the bomb-racks. 5,398 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs were returned to base, not having been dropped, due to cloud interference. 1 B-26 lost: crash landed at Nancy, due to flak damage. Some crew members were injured, but otherwise the crew is safe (crew has not yet returned to this base). No B-26's missing. 8 B-26's slightly damaged by flak, and 3 B-26's seriously by flak and fragments from bombs which exploded prematurely under the formation. 60 B-26's returned to base at 14:36 hours and 1 B-26 returned late at 16:30 hours, after landing at Luneyville for fuel. 1 B-26 went to Dijon A/D with injured crew member, crew returned to base, but a/c is still at Dijon A/D.

FLAK: S, H, I, I, -GP type flak encountered from Steinbach W-2367, both going in and coming out. Total of 20 bursts were seen. 1 of a/c received holes from this flak.

S, H, A, A, -CP type flak encountered from South-East of the target, beginning on the breakaway, lasting for 30 seconds, on both bomb-runs. It was accurate for some Squadrons and inaccurate for others.

ROUTE: Base to rendezvous, with escort, at Colmar V-7242; to Selestat V-7962; to W-2763; to W-6778; to Hechingen W-9173; to Rentlingen X-0989; to Blaubeuren X-5181; to IP, Lanpheim X-5961; to target on the first bomb-run; curve right to IP; to target on an Axis of 219°T; on the second bomb-run; breakaway right to Hechingen W-9173; reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER:

a. Enroute: :-1-2/10ths cumulus, chiefly over mountains, bases estimated 8,000', tops 10-11000'. Vis. excellent in light haze.

b. Vicinity of Target: :- 3-4/10ths cumulus, increasing to the South, tops

c. Target Area: :- 10-11,000', with occasional tops above 12,000'.

Vis. excellent. A cloud directly over the target necessitated two (2) bomb-runs.

d. Return: :- Generally same as enroute, with occasional cumulus tops building above 12,000'.

RESULTS: An excellent pattern covered the wooded dispersal area in the center of the target area.
