INGOLSTADT KOSCHING AMMUNITION DUMP, AREA "D" (M/R: (W) T-744279, GSOS 4416, Sheet V-6), Germany.

At 09:03 hours, 20 B-26's took off to bomb Ingolstadt Kosching Ammunition Dump, Area "D" (M/R: (W) T-744279, GSOS 4416, Sheet V-6), Germany. 2 B-26's returned early: spares. Total Sorties: 18. No B-26's were over the target. The formation turned back at 10:59 hours at 12,000' at T-1648, due to complete overcast in the target area. No bombs were salvoed. All bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 12:35 hours.

a. Activity:

- (1) 1 S/S U/I a/c at S-9057 at 500' flying East at 10:50 hours.
- (2) P-47's provided escort.

b. Situation: None.

- (2) 50 M/T headed West out of Crailsheim S-7162 at 10:41 hours.

ROUTE: Base to Spinal V-0454; to Saverne Q-7316; to rendezvous with escort at Speyer R-5080; to Crailsheim S-7162; to T-1648; curve right to Crailsheim S-7162; reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER:

- a. Enroute: Scattered stratocumulus, bases 7,000', tops 9,000', becoming 8/10ths East of the Rhine and 10/10ths East of Crailsheim.
- b. Vicinity of and Target Area: 10/10ths stratocumulus, bases 7,000', tops 9,000'. Target covered.
- c. Return: Cloud cover increasing, with stratocumulus moving down from the North.

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RESULT: None.

SPECIAL COMMENTS: This mission was briefed as visual mission.

Additional Comments: The crew which landed at Y-79, this date, returned to base at 19:00 hours, but left a/c there for engine change. This a/c jettisoned 14 x 260-lb. Frags at S-5866 at 12:00 hours, due to engine trouble.

The a/c which landed at Y-79 on the 17 April, 1945, returned to base at 19:00 hours, this date.

On Final Mission Report No. 573, this date, change the bomb status from No bombs salvoed, to read, 14 x250-lb. Fragmentation bombs were salvoed at S-5866 at 12:00 hours, due to engine trouble.
