SCHWABMUNCHEN AMMO DUMP, AREA "D", (M/R: (M) Y-318547, GSOS 4416, sheet X5) Germany.

At 06:22 hours 36 B-26's took off to bomb Schwabmunchen Ammunition dump (M/R: (M) Y-318547, GSOS 4416, Sheet X5), Germany - Area "D". 1 B-26 returned early; engineering. Total Sorties: 35. 35 B-26's were over the primary target and 35 B-26's dropped 475 x 250-lb demolition bombs (.1 & .025 second delay tail fuses) on the primary target at 10:28 hours from 11,800' to 10,600' on an axis of 237 Deg. True (Briefed Axis - 238 Deg. True; Drift Correction - None; Evasive Action - Loss of Altitude). 7 x 250-lb demolition bombs were salvoed at 10:28 hours at the target, having hung up. No bombs were returned to base. (4 A/C carried only 12 bombs because they were "BAT" Lead A/C). No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 35 B-26's returned to Base at 12:03 hours.
