LACHFIELD AIRFIELD, AREA "E" (M/R: (W) Y-320620, GSGS 4416, Sheet X5), Germany.

At 06:47 hours, 27 B-26's took off to bomb Lachfield Airfield, Area "E" (M/R: (W) Y-320620, GSGS 4416, Sheet X5), Germany. No B-26's returned early. Total Sorties: 27. No B-26's were over the target. The formation turned back at T-4515, due to weather at 10:48 hours at 7,500'. No bombs were dropped, and no bombs were salvoed. All bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 27 B-26's returned to base at 12:44 hours.

ROUTE: Base to Selestat V-7962; to rendezvous at Offenburg W-1587; to Rentlingen X-0989; to X-5067; to Rentlingen X-0989; to Nordlingen T-0332; to T-4515; to Nordlingen T-0332; reciprocal course to base.

WEATHER:

a. Enroute : Generally 6-7/10ths coverage consisting of stratocumulus deck, base 5,500', tops 10,000', with frequent cumulus tops building up to an estimated 15,000'. Above the stratocumulus top there were multilayered altostratus decks mixed in between the cumulus tops. Vis. 8 - 10 miles in haze.

b. Vicinity and Target Area: At O.P. a solid wall of thick altostratus built up from the top of the stratocumulus to an estimated 15,000', cutting off all access to the target.

c. Return : Cloud coverage increased to 10/10ths.
