LECHFIELD AIRFIELD, AREA "H" (M/R: (W) Y-320620, GSGS 4416, sheet X5), Germany.

At 09:04 hours, 19 B-26's took off to bomb Lechfield Airfield, Area "H" (M/R: (W) Y-320620, GSGS 4416, Sheet X5), Germany. 1 B-26 returned early. Total sorties: 18. No B-26's were over the target. The formation turned back at T-5515 at 11:30 hours at 7,600', due to weather. The B-26 listed above as returning early, returned because of engine cutting-out. 3 x 20-lb. Frag. bombs were jettisoned at V-5360 at 09:40 hours through camera hatch, due to defective fusing wires. A/C was flying over open field, but bombs were not seen to hit or explode. All other bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 18 B-26's returned to base at 13:06 hours.
