TROOP CONCENTRATION, AREA "H", ILE D'OLERON (M/R: (V) T-215035, GSOS 4249, Sheet 6M), France.

At 13:10 hours, 20 B-26's took off to bomb Troop Concentration, Area "H", Ile D'Oléron (M/R: (V) T-215035, GSOS 4249, Sheet 6M), France. 1 B-26 returned early: engine cutting-out. Total Sorties: 19. 19 B-26's were over the Primary target and 18 B-26's dropped 2,160 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs on the Primary target at 16:06 hours from 12,500' to 12,000' on an Axis of 59°T (briefed Axis - 58°T; drift correction - 06° left; evasive action - loss of altitude). 120 x 20-lb. Fragmentation bombs were salvoed at 16:06 hours at the target, having hung up. No bombs were returned to base. No B-26's lost or missing. No B-26's damaged. 19 B-26's returned to base at 17:47 hours.
